


REPLACING EXPIRED REFERENDUM REVENUE AUTHORIZATION - MAINTAIN STUDENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS The Board of Independent School District No. 15 has proposed to increase its general education revenue by \$671.65 per pupil. A portion of this proposed referendum authorization would replace the school district's prior authorization which has expired. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would be an increase of \$287.90 per pupil over the school district's expired authorization. The proposed new referendum revenue authorization would increase each year by the rate of inflation and be applicable for seven (7) years unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by law.
