THE PROPOSED REFERENDUM REVENUE AUTHORIZATION WOULD BE AN INCREASE OF \$287.90 PER PUPIL OVER THE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S EXPIRED AUTHORIZATION. THE PROPOSED NEW REFERENDUM REVENUE AUTHORIZATION WOULD INCREASE EACH YEAR BY THE RATE OF INFLATION AND BE APPLICABLE FOR SEVEN (7) YEARS UNLESS OTHERWISE REVOKED OR REDUCED AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
