The board of Independent School District No. 279 (Coseo Area Schools) has proposed to increase its general education revenue by \$336.31 per pupit. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would increase each year by the rate of inflation and be applicable for ten years unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by law.
