SCHOOL DISTRICT BALLOT QUESTION 1  
REVOKING EXISTING REFERENDUM REVENUE AUTHORIZATION; APPROVING NEW AUTHORIZATION

The board of Independent School District No. 281 (Robbinsdale Area Schools) has proposed to revoke the school district's existing referendum revenue authorization of \$848.25 per pupil and to replace that authorization with a new authorization of \$1,360.35 per pupil.
