PROPOSED LANGUAGE ORDINANCES
SECTION 6.00. (When Required). Subd. 3.
The Common Council may provide by ordinance that a violation of a city ordinance is either a misdemeanor or a petty misdemeanor **BOB BARR AND** CLEAN WATER, WILDLIFE, WAYNE A. ROOT **CULTURAL HERITAGE AND** Libertarian **NATURAL AREAS** Shall the Minnesota Constitution be amended to dedicate funding to protect our drinking water sources; to protect, enhance, and restore our wetlands, prairies, forests, and fish, game, and wildlife habitat; to preserve our arts and cultural heritage; to support our parks and trails; and to protect, enhance, and restore our lakes, rivers, streams, and groundwater by increasing the sales and use tax rate beginning July 1, 2009, by three-eighths of one percent on taxable sales until the year 2034? **CHUCK BALDWIN AND** punishable in accordance with state law. In addition, the Council may establish by ordinance DARRELL CASTLE a procedure for imposing a civil perialty for each ordinance violation. The procedure must provide for an opportunity for a hearing before a neutral party, which may be the Council.
