PROPOSED LANGUAGE ORDINANCES CLEAN WATER, WILDLIFE **BOB BARR AND** WAYNE A. ROOT CULTURAL HERITAGE AND SECTION 6.00. (When Required). Subd. 3. The Common Council may provide by ordinance that a violation of a city ordinance is either a **NATURAL AREAS** Shall the Minnesota Constitution be amended to dedicate funding to protect our drinking water sources; to protect, enhance, and restore our wetlands, prairies, forests, and fish, game, and wildlife habitat; to preserve our arts and cultural heritage; to support our parks and trails; and to protect, enhance, and restore our lakes, rivers, streams, and groundwater by increasing the misdemeanor or a petty misdemeanor punishable in accordance with state law. In CHUCK BALDWIN AND DARRELL CASTLE addition, the Council may establish by ordinance a procedure for imposing a civil penalty for each ordinance violation.
