The prior referendum revenue authorization of \$841.22 per pupil of Independent School District No. 719 (Prior Lake/Savage Area Schools) has expired. The Board has proposed a new authorization that would be \$210 per pupil greater than the school district's expired authorization and that would increase the school district's authorization to \$1,051.22 per pupil. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would be applicable for ten years unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by law. Shall the increase in the revenue proposed by the board of Independent School District No. 719 be approved?
