The Board has proposed a new authorization that would be \$210 per pupil greater than the school district's expired authorization and that would increase the school district's authorization to \$1,051.22 per pupil. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would be applicable for ten years unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by law.
