Section 2.06. The Mayor, The Mayor shall be the presiding officer of the Council except that the Council shall choose from its members a president pro term who shall hold office at the pleasure of the Council and shall serve as president in the Mayor's absence and as Mayor in case of the Mayor's disability or absence from the City or as otherwise provided by this Charter. The Mayor shall have a vote as a member of the Council. The Mayor shall exercise all powers and perform all duties conferred and imposed upon the Mayor shall exercise all powers and perform all duties conferred and imposed upon the Mayor shall be recognized as the official head of the City for all ceremonial purposes, by the courts for the purpose of serving civil process, and by the governor for the purposes of martial law. The Mayor shall study the operations of the City government and shall report to the Council any neglect, dereliction of duty, or waste on the part of any officer or department of the City. In time of public danger or emergency the Mayor may, with the consent of the Council, or as may be provided for in and consistent with the City Municipal Code, take command of the police, maintain order and enforce the law. The Mayor shall from time to time give the Council such information and recommend such measures as the Mayor may deem advantageous to the City.
