CITY QUESTION #2: AMENDMENT TO CITY CHARTER, SECTION 2.06, THE MAYOR.

Section 2.06. The Mayor. The Mayor shall be the presiding officer of the Council except that the Council shall choose from its members a president pro tem who shall hold office at the pleasure of the Council and shall serve as president in the Mayor's absence and as Mayor in case of the Mayor's disability or absence from the City or as otherwise provided by this Charter. The Mayor shall have a vote as a member of the Council. The Mayor shall exercise all powers and perform all duties conferred and imposed upon the Mayor by this Charter, the Ordinances of the City, and the laws of the State. The Mayor shall be recognized as the official head of the City for all ceremonial purposes, by the courts for the purpose of serving civil process, and by the governor for the purposes of martial law. The Mayor shall study the operations of the City government and shall report to the Council any neglect, dereliction of duty, or waste on the part of any officer or department of the City. In time of public danger or emergency the Mayor may, with the consent of the Council, or as may be provided for in and consistent with the City Emergency Plan as provided for in the City Municipal Code, take command of the police, maintain order and enforce the law. The Mayor shall from time to time give the Council such information and recommend such measures as the Mayor may deem advantageous to the City.

CITY QUESTION #3: AMENDMENT TO CITY CHARTER, SECTION 2.09, CENSURE OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL.

Section 2.09. Censure of the Mayor or any other Member of the City Council. On a motion of the City Council approved by not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the full City Council, the City Council may censure a member of the Council for behavior it has determined is inappropriate or disrespectful toward the Council as a whole, or any member thereof, including the office of City Council member, a member of City Staff, a City Consultant, or a member of the Public.

Section 12.12. Economic Development Authority Commissioners. Commissioners appointed to a City Economic Development Authority established pursuant to MSA 469.091 or laws supplementary thereto, shall be residents and qualified electors of the City of Lake City, except as may be otherwise specifically provided for in the enabling resolution or amendments thereto establishing such Economic Development Authority.
