RÓGER CALERO AND ALYSON KENNEDY Socialist Workers Section 2.02.Boards and Commissions.The Council shall create a Marina Board to exercise powers and duties relating to marina and waterfront matters; a Utility Board to exercise powers and duties relating to marina and waterfront matters; a Utility Board to exercise powers and duties relating to water, sewer, storm water and electricity; and may create by ordinance if it deems necessary, such other boards and commissions to advise the Council with respect to any municipal function or activity, to investigate any subject of interest to the City or to perform quasi-judicial functions. All Board and Commission members shall be residents and qualified electors of the City of Lake City except as to those appointed as Advisory members of Boards and Commissions.
